### Financial Assistance

If you need financial assistance for tuition, fees and books, you may be eligible for federal, state, local or private assistance through loans, grants or scholarships.

FACTS PROGRAM: Carroll Community College offers a FACTS monthly payment program to enable you to more easily afford your educational expenses if your tuition is \$200 or more. Go to [www.carroll.edu](http://www.carroll.edu) for more information.

The Carroll County Business and Employment Resource Center (BERC) offers financial assistance to eligible clients. Contact BERC, 410-386-2820.

Many employers offer tuition reimbursement for eligible employees. Check with your employer. If your employer wishes to pay the full cost of your training, that can easily be arranged through the Continuing Education & Training office.

#### Registration
