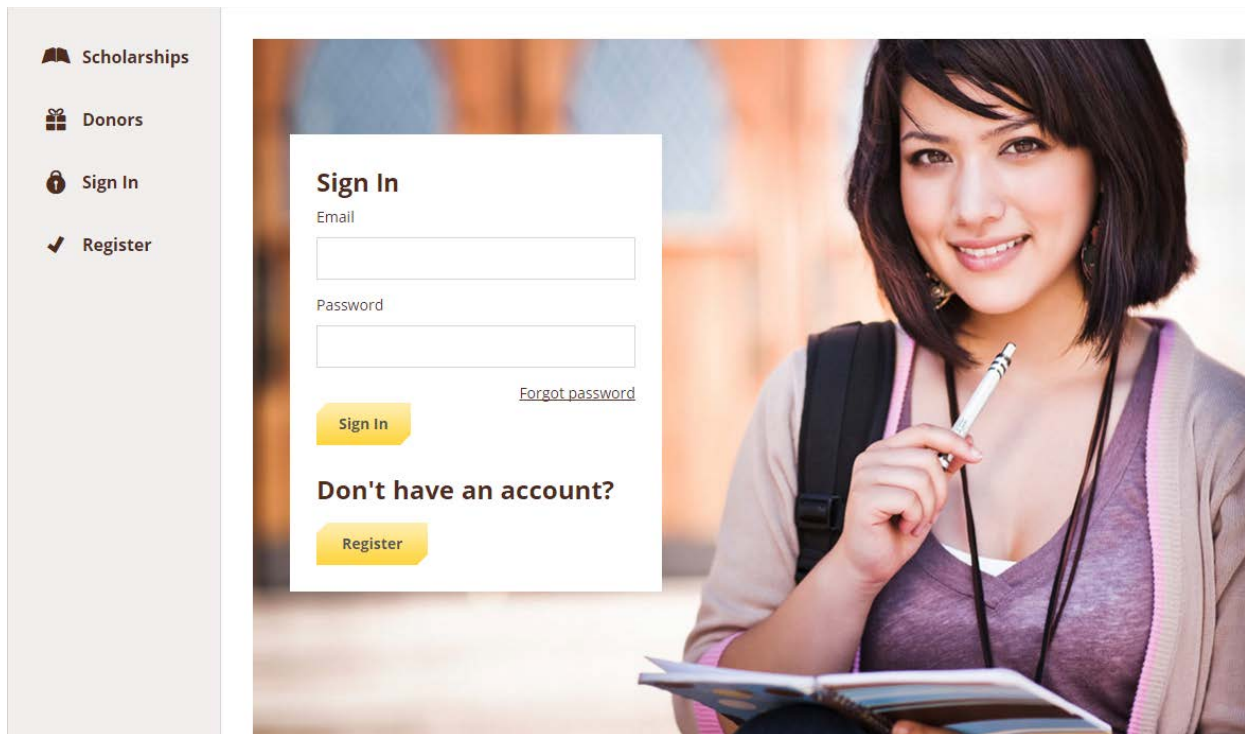


Navigating AwardSpring: A Guide for Applicants

The purpose of this guide is to walk you through the process of applying for scholarships using the AwardSpring platform.

Start by navigating to your organization's site [AwardSpring](#).

You will land at the login page. (Please note that this page is customizable so your organization's login page may look different than the below example.)



In the left menu bar, both Scholarships and Donors are clickable buttons.

Scholarships will show you a list of all scholarships that are being offered by your organization along with their respective award amounts and deadlines.
