### **1** Apply for GI Bill Benefits

Go to the VA website: www.va.gov/education/how-to-apply

Beneath **"How do I apply?"**, select **"Find your education benefits form"** and complete the application to receive a Certificate of Eligibility (COE). If done correctly, the final page will contain a confirmation number for your COE. Print this page for your records.

VA will review application and issue applicant a letter.
