E. Household Income/Tax Return Information

This will link your tax return, but not your W2s, 1099s or Schedule C. This process will provide us your information within 3 to 5 business days. –or-
- 2. Visit IRS.gov and print a copy of your <u>TAX RETURN TRANSCRIPT</u> (not an account transcript). If you cannot print out a copy, you can request a copy be mailed to you. This process takes 5 to 10 business days. –or-
- 3. Call the IRS at 1-800-908-9946 to request a copy of your **<u>TAX RETURN TRANSCRIPT</u>** (not an account transcript) to be mailed to you. This process takes 5 to 10 business days.
