Phi Theta Kappa and "HonorSociety.org" Public Service Announcement

This is a public service announcement to all students to beware of misleading organizations posing as legitimate honor societies. There are several legitimate honors options at Carroll, including the Pappalardo Scholars Program, the STEM Scholars program, the Lynx Scholars Program, and the Phi Theta Kappa Honors Society (PTK).

It has come to our attention that students across the nation have been deceived into joining HonorSociety.org, thinking that they were joining PTK. Anyone receiving an email from HonorSociety.org should be advised that this is **not** a legitimate honor society and has no association with PTK, which enjoys the unique distinction of being the only internationally

recognized honor society for community colleges.

Before accepting an invitation to join an honor society, always verify its legitimacy by checking with your college or by visiting trusted sources like PTK's official website at **ptk.org**. Protect your academic achievements!

Date: Thursday, Oct. 17


