Changes to Precalculus Classes at Carroll

For non-STEM related majors, we will begin offering a one-semester College Algebra class (MATH 118) in Fall 2022. For STEM related majors, we will continue offering a one-semester Precalculus class (MATH 130) which is a prerequisite for Calculus 1.

The last time that MATH 124 (Precalculus Part 2) will be offered is Summer 2022. Students who are preparing for Calculus I (MATH 135) for Fall 2022 must complete and pass MATH 124 by Summer 2022. Otherwise, Precalculus (MATH 130) will be the prerequisite for Calculus I (MATH 135).

Cell Phone Reception on Campus

Mobile carriers are decommissioning their 3G networks, which rely on older technology, to make room for more advanced network services. As a result, older cell phones may be unable to make or receive calls and texts, including calls to 911, or use data services. This will affect 3G mobile phones and certain older 4G mobile phones that do not support Voice over LTE (VoLTE or HD Voice).

While cell phones that support 4G and 5G are not impacted by the phase-out, the signal inside buildings may be impacted as the 3G signal was better at penetrating walls. As a result, cell phone coverage at the college may be impacted. IT will be evaluating technology options to boost 4G and potentially 5G signals inside the buildings.

In the interim, you can enable Wi-Fi calling on your cell phone and make sure you are connected to the college's open Wi-Fi network. This may help in receiving and making calls. Please note, these directions may vary by carrier and phone.
