Important details and dates:

- All student work needs to arrive to Jessi Hardesty by end of day on Monday, 4/14. Artwork drop-off locations: T405 (under the chalkboard) and T413 (Lisa Deyerberg's office).
- The exhibition will be on view from April 21 to June 7.
- Opening reception will be on Thursday, May 1 from 3:00 to 6:00 pm. Your attendance is strongly encouraged- there will be food and awards!
- Location: Babylon Great Hall

Rules and reminders:

- Each student may submit up to two pieces of artwork for inclusion in the exhibition.
- All works must be properly labeled with the artist's name, title of work, medium, and what class/instructor the project is from (or label as personal project if not associated with a class).
- All two-dimensional works must be securely framed, wired, and ready to hang. No sawtooth hangers or d-rings; secure wires only. Canvases may be unframed if they are properly wired.
- All three-dimensional works must be properly padded, packaged, and labeled. There is limited space available for three-dimensional work, so please think small.
- All students submitting work must also email Jessi (jhardesty@carrollcc.edu) directly by end of day on Monday, 4/14 with title card information (artist's name, title of work, medium, and what class/instructor the project is from) as well as corresponding images of their submissions.
- The curator reserves the right to refuse pieces that are improperly framed, damaged, or similar.
- Space is limited, so there may not be space for every submission. Curator will do their best to be as inclusive as possible but cannot guarantee inclusion of all submissions in the exhibition.
- Current credit students who have taken Visual Arts courses in between Fall 2024 and now, Visual Arts majors, and non-credit students who have taken Art courses in the last year are eligible to submit work.

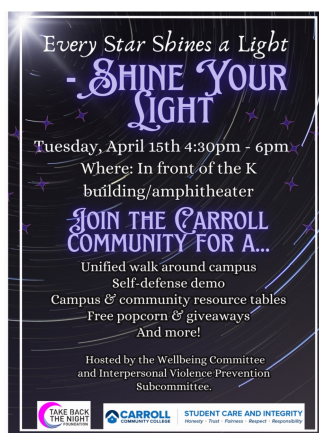

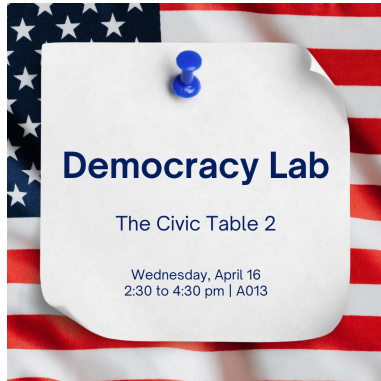

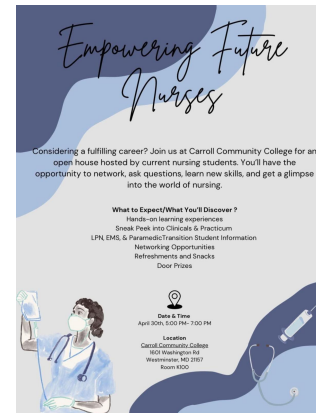
SGO Pet Charity Event
