Scholarship Applications Reopen This Month!

Looking to get money toward your education? Look no further, as scholarship applications are open for the last time from July 21 to August 4. Scholarships are great opportunities to help you afford school, and they do not need to be paid back like loans do.

Merit and need-based scholarships are available. Remember to fill out your FAFSA and have it sent to Carroll Community College! Carroll's Federal School Code is **031007**.

New Health and Wellness Vending Machine on Campus!

A health and wellness vending machine, located on the second floor of the L Building, is now available for student and employee use. The machine provides access to over-the-counter items commonly found in drugstores and supermarkets, as well as contraceptive products, as required by state law. The 2024 Maryland General Assembly passed legislation (SB 527/HB 367) mandating all community colleges provide students with access to contraception no later than August 1, 2025. All the contraceptives included in Carroll's Health and Wellness Vending Machine are FDA-approved and can be found over the counter in any drugstore in the country.

The machine also provides access to other health and wellness items. A focus group of student leaders helped identify these items, which include pregnancy tests, eye drops, Tylenol, Ibuprofen, Benadryl, Baby Wipes, Contact Lens solution, ChapStick, and cough drops. Other items included in the machine are USB wall chargers, USB C charging wires, and hair ties. All items are available for purchase by any student or employee of the College. Naloxone is also provided in the machine, free of charge.

Coming Fall 2025: Maryland State Legislature!

Are you interested in pursuing a career in law, government, policy making, advocacy, public service, social work, or media? If so, you should consider participating in Carroll's new Maryland Student Legislature Program (MSL)! This program is offered in partnership with McDaniel College as a credit option in the Fall (2 credits) and a co-curricular (i.e., non-credit) option in the Spring.

Inspired by the Model UN program, the MSL offers students from across the state an immersive experience in the workings of state and local government. Through it, you'll be given first-hand, in-depth understanding of how political and social change happen. Learn how to turn your ideas for improving your community into real laws, gain valuable leadership experience, and make friends from all across the state.

This experience makes an excellent pairing with PSLS 125 (Constitutional Law) and looks great on a transfer application!


SAVE THE DATE for Stevenson University Online's Virtual Open House! The Open House is on
