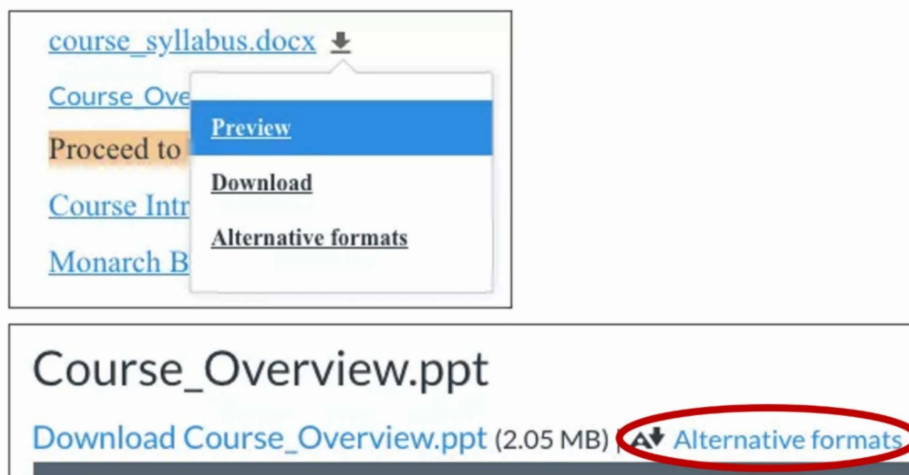

Alternative Course Formats in Canvas

Did you know you can download alternative formats of content in your Canvas courses? Click on the Download icon and select Alternative formats or the Alternative Formats link to see a list of available formats including:

- PDF for viewing on mobile devices
- Audio
- Mobile-friendly HTML

Alternative formats make it easier for you to have content delivered in the way you want it.



What is Immersive Reader?

Immersive Reader is a learning tool in Canvas that uses proven techniques to improve reading for everyone. Key features include:

- Change font size, text spacing, and background color
- Split words into syllables
- Highlight verbs, nouns, adjectives, and sub-clauses
- Choose between two fonts optimized to help with reading
- Read text aloud
- Change the speed of reading
- Highlight sets of one, three, or five lines for greater focus
- Select a word to see a related picture and hear the word read aloud as many times as necessary

To turn on the Immersive Reader, click the Immersive Reader button at the top right of any Canvas page. Note: You will need to turn it on for every Canvas page you open.

Microsoft Word also has Immersive Reader. To use it:

1. Open a Word document.
2. Select the View tab and click Immersive Reader button.
3. Choose the Immersive Reader Options from the ribbon.

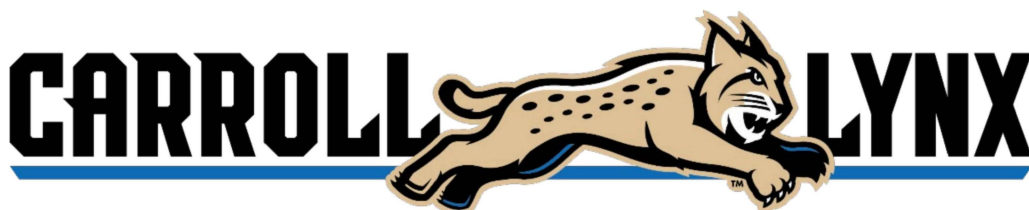
