Sign Up for the Carroll Food Locker Program!!

The Carroll Food Locker Program is a grocery assistance program. Clients can access items such as fresh produce, frozen meats, nonperishable items, hygiene products, and diapers. There are no financial requirements and any current



student, faculty, or staff is eligible for the program.

The Food Locker is located on the lower level of the A building underneath the stairs in A002.

Food Locker hours are:

- Mondays, Tuesdays, and Fridays from 10 am to 1 pm
- Wednesdays and Thursdays from 2 to 6 pm


