Multifactor Authentication (MFA) for Students

Students registered for a course that has a Canvas component will be required to set up and use MFA to access college resources. MFA is a system that verifies a user's identity by requiring two or more authentication methods for secure login. This will enhance security when accessing college resources from your mobile device or home computer. MFA will be used when accessing college systems from devices not connected to the college's network. Systems include but are not limited to Microsoft 365 (Outlook, OneDrive, Teams), Canvas, Lynx Student Portal, and Library databases. We strongly recommend setting up more than one verification method including the Microsoft Authenticator app and completing the process before August 22.

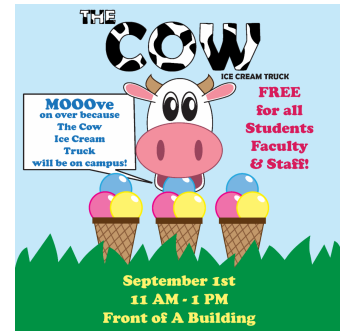
