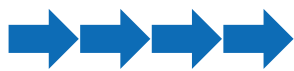

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Why should someone attend Carroll Community College?

A: Carroll Community College offers lower costs, easier admission policies, close ties to state schools, and many of the required courses connected to a degree. The types of services we offer aim to cater to the specific needs of our local community.

Q: What is the academic calendar for Carroll Community College?

A: The academic year usually runs from August through May, with breaks for holidays. Carroll uses a semester system.

Q: Do you have transfer agreements with universities?

A: Yes, we have transfer agreements with various universities so our students can continue their education at one of the four-year universities.

Q: Do you offer online courses?

A: Yes, we offer some courses online for our students.

Q: What are English language proficiency requirements?

A: At Carroll, we require an English language proficiency test before admission to ensure you can read, write, and speak fluently.

Q: Does the College offer career services to students and graduates?

A: We have career services offices that offer resources such as career counseling or workshops on creating resumes, for example.

Q: What type of opportunities do you offer to nontraditional students?

A: We have many resources to assist nontraditional adult learners who may be juggling school with work, family, and other obligations. For instance, we offer day care, a food locker, and flexible course delivery options.
