- Assorted pre-packaged snack, candy and pastry items
- Assorted bottled and fountain beverages
- Fresh coffee served from Starbucks (*limited menu available)

Note: Hot entrees and salad bar are suspended until further notice

Vending Machine Availability

- A “fresh meals” refrigerated vending machine is located in the Café vending area.
- **After 1:30 pm each weekday, the machine is stocked with fresh foods for evening students and employees**
- Food choices include sandwiches, salads, wraps, hummus, among other items.
- A “healthy options” refrigerated vending machine is located in the N Building.
- Beverages and dry snacks are located in A, K, L, M, N, P, and T Buildings.
- Microwaves continue to be available near the vending machines in the A, K, N, and T buildings.

The Café is **CLOSED** for the same holidays and breaks as the campus:

- Spring Recess: Sunday, March 19 through Sunday, March 26
- Memorial Day Holiday: Saturday, May 27 through Monday, May 29

Please note that we will not offer Food Trucks on campus after winter break due to the cold temperatures, dwindling daylight hours, and low sales. The plan is to re-evaluate the offerings and consider inviting the trucks to return in March after Spring Break.

1098T Tax Documents are Ready!

1098T tax documents are now available on the Lynx portal. To access your 1098T, go to www.carrollcc.edu/myCarroll, log in, and click on **Tax Information**. You'll need to sign the electronic consent before you can see the forms. After you give consent, click on **1098T** and **Tax Year 2022**. An added option, **View Account and Make Payment**, is available to assist you in determining total payments made during the calendar year.

Sign Up for the Carroll Food Locker for Free Groceries!

The Carroll Food Locker Program is a grocery assistance program. Clients can access items such as fresh produce, frozen meats, nonperishable items, hygiene products, and pet food. There are no financial requirements and any current student, faculty, or staff is eligible for the program.

The Food Locker is located on the lower level of the A building underneath the stairs in A002.

Food Locker hours are:

- Mondays from 11 am to 3 pm
- Tuesdays from 1 to 4 pm
- Wednesdays from 10:30 am to 2:30 pm
- Thursdays from 3 to 6 pm

- Fridays from 10 am to 1 pm
