### Refuse to Be Compromised: Integrity Council's Suggestions for Spring 2023

It's essential to each student and instructor's integrity to understand and practice "certain standards of academic honesty and social conduct" here at Carroll (Carroll's Code of Integrity). However, many students and instructors aren't sure where to find resources that are easily accessible, clear, and specific to our Carroll community.

In this series, we will discuss the Integrity Council's Top 3 Suggestions for a great Spring 2023.

#### Suggestion #2: ONLINE TOOLS CAN BE AN IMPORTANT PART OF YOUR COURSE!

We are in the time of AI Writing Bots. They can cause a major headache for instructors and serve as a temptation for a student short of time. So, as members of the Carroll community, not only do we have to keep each other honest, but we also must stay ahead of the technological curve. Online tools like Turnitin's Draft Coach can detect writing created by an AI. In addition, Turnitin's Draft Coach can help student writers check their own work for citation and grammar errors. Turnitin's Draft Coach is available for any student or faculty member; simply sign into the online version of Word via your Microsoft 365 account to get started.


