#### **Trumpower Foundation Scholarship**

Last year, The Harold Glen and Audrey G. Benson Trumpower Foundation Scholarship Fund awarded 68 scholarships to Carroll County students, totaling close to \$700,000. Applications for the 2023-24 school year must be completed online, and will be accepted through March 31. Scholarships are awarded to Carroll County residents who are pursuing post-secondary education, including undergraduate and graduate degrees, or certifications. Scholarship money can be used to pay tuition, room and board, books, and other fees; and can be used for part-time or full-time study.


