## Articulation Agreement Between Carroll Community College And Baltimore Electricians JATC's Apprenticeship Program

Program of Study: Technical and Professional Studies

This Articulation Agreement is made by and between Carroll Community College, 1601 Washington Rd., Westminster, MD 21157, and Baltimore Electrical Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee (JATC), 2699W. Patapsco Ave., Suite 200, Baltimore, MD 21230.

WHEREAS the Electrical Apprenticeship program (hereinafter "the Program") provides 800 hours of classroom instruction and requires 10,000 hours of on-the-job training in providing electrical services under the direction and control of a licensed electrical contractor, and

WHEREAS Carroll Community College (hereinafter "the College") is authorized by the Maryland Department of Higher Education Commission to grant education components of approved A.A.S. degree programs, and

WHEREAS this agreement recognizes that the program provides the career training in electrical work and those who subsequently enroll in the A.A.S. degree in Technical and Professional Studies may receive an A.A.S. degree upon the successful completion of the courses required in this agreement and in accordance with all state regulations; and

Students who have graduated from the Program in prior years and have kept current their electrical journeyperson certificate from the Maryland Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation (DLLR) and subsequently enroll in the A.A.S. degree in Technical and Professional Studies program may receive an A.A.S. degree upon the successful completion of the courses required in this agreement and in accordance with all state regulations; and

This agreement becomes effective upon the signature of all parties and shall continue in effect unless voided by either party upon sixty (60) days prior written notice. This agreement will be reviewed and renewed by both parties every five years. Within each five-year period, the Program and the College will consider, in good faith, any proposed amendments. The Agreement may only be amended by written amendments signed by both parties.

This agreement may be terminated by either party for due cause and after adequate notice to the other. Any students currently enrolled in a class at the Program when this agreement is in effect may enroll at the College under the terms of this agreement upon graduation from the Program.

Students who satisfactorily complete the electrical journeyperson apprenticeship training program approved by the Maryland Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation may receive 30 credits to apply toward graduation in the Technical and Professional Studies A.A.S. provided they successfully complete the additional courses listed on Attachment A. Evidence of the completed apprenticeship must be submitted to Carroll Community College's Records Office at registrar@carrollcc.edu.
