

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING



Between

SWANSEA UNIVERSITY
(United Kingdom)



And

CARROLL COMMUNITY COLLEGE
(Maryland, USA)

Background

(A) SWANSEA UNIVERSITY with registered office at Singleton Park, Swansea, SA2 8PP and the CARROLL COMMUNITY COLLEGE registered address at 1601 Washington Road, Westminster, MD 21157 wish to enter this Memorandum of Understanding ("Memorandum") to promote academic collaboration and to develop further the friendly relationship between these two academic institutions ("Collaboration"). Each a Party and together the Parties.

(B) This Memorandum sets out the proposed terms of the Collaboration. It is not exhaustive and is not intended to be legally binding.

(C) This Memorandum is confidential to the parties and their advisers.

(D) The schedule forms part of this Memorandum and shall have effect as if set out in full in the body of this Memorandum. Any reference to this Memorandum includes the Schedule.

Collaboration

1. In order to promote the Collaboration, the parties agree to negotiate in good faith to explore the possibility of developing collaborative activities which are mutually beneficial, to include but not be limited to:

1.1 Promoting working partnerships between the parties' respective staff and students/scholars

To include, but not be limited to:

- Research collaboration in areas of mutual interest.
- Identification and development of key areas of common interest as stand-alone projects.
- Discussions in relation to student recruitment.

1.2 Facilitating Entry to Swansea University degree programmes and modules



5. Any aspect of the Collaboration that is not mentioned in this Memorandum shall be discussed, agreed and/or resolved (as applicable) through mutual agreement, and each party covenants that it will make good faith efforts to reach such agreement.
6. This Memorandum constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and shall supersede and extinguish all previous agreements, promises, assurances, warranties, representations, understandings, arrangements and undertakings between the parties, whether written or oral, relating to its subject matter.
7. If either Party to this Memorandum wish to formalise any of the activities mentioned in clause 1, then a legally binding agreement shall be set up between the Parties.
8. The Memorandum shall commence when signed by an Authorised Representative of SWANSEA UNIVERSITY and the appropriate Principal Officer of CARROLL COMMUNITY COLLEGE.
